# Terra Cotta Corazón

**SUPPLIES:** Clay, templates, knife, sheet of paper.

**NEEDED:** Rolling pin, cup of water.

**DIRECTIONS:** Roll out the clay to be about 10" x 5. Place the template on top and cut out the shape, as well as the ribbon on another part of the clay.

Smooth edges with wet finer. Cut out embellishments, scores where both sides meets and press pieces in place.

Let dry for 48 hours before painting. Add glaze if desired.



# Manifestation Pillow

**SUPPLIES:** Fabric, template, stuffing, needle & thread. **NEEDED:** Scissors, pins.

## DIRECTIONS:

Set aside the "artista" fabric.

Stack the three others fabric pieces, fold in half. Trace the pattern on them, cut, open the fabric hearts.

Take one piece to be the pocket, fold the heart flaps down to create hem, and stitch across.

Choose a piece for the back, pin or baste folded piece to be the pocket.

Front piece, cut out he "artista" and stitch her to the center of the heart.

## FABRIC PILLOW continued

Layer front and back pieces, right sides together.

Stitch around the edges and leave a 1-1/2" opening.

Backstitch on each end and reverse the pillow so right sides face out.

Add stuffing to upper right area of the pillow. Line up the opened area and the hems and stitch shut.

Move stuffing so it looks balanced.



NOTE: You can use a sewing machine if you do not want to hand stitch.

## PILLOW TEMPLATE:

You can draw your own heart template or use mine. Simply fold a piece of printer paper in half and draw a HALF a heart about 3.5" across and 5-6" tall.

Cut it out and use it for your fabric layers.

# Repyjado Matchboxes

**SUPPLIES:** Matchbox, soda can, glue, paint, craft foam pen. **NEEDED:** Scissors, nail file.

**DIRECTIONS:** Open the matchboxes and put the matches in a tin can or glass jar.

Use craft paint to add color to the inner sleeve and the sides and the back of each matchbox.

Add painted accents, let dry and coat with brush-on sealer.

Use the glue stick for paper and add the dichos to the inside of the sleeve.

## Matchboxes continued:

Cut the aluminum to the size of the matchbox cover.

File the edges so they are not sharp.

Place the piece on the piece of craft foam.

Draw your design with the ballpoint pen or thin embossing stylus, press hard so your lines are deeply recessed.

Flip over the aluminum piece and use the pen cap or pencil eraser on the areas within the lines you drew.

Flip it over again and continue working on both sides until you like what you see.

When done, place the piece, printed side up and use glue to fill the recesses let dry, place it on the matchbox.

Glue down all the edges so it's secure.

Use paint or markers to add color to the tin.

For faster dry time, use hot glue instead of white glue.



# Valentine Booklet

**SUPPLIES:** Black card, scrapbook paper, 2 sheets printer paper cut in half widthwise, embellishments, dry adhesive, printer paper, hole punch, twine.

**DIRECTIONS:** Fold the printer paper in half, crease. Insert inside card, use hole punch on each end. Tie with twine.

Line the front of card with scrapbook paper, add embellishments.

Add decorative accents on the pages inside the card.

# Heartful Painted Earrings

**SUPPLIES:** Wood blank earrings, wood heart, glue, paint, earring findings.

**DIRECTIONS:** Base coat the background wood pieces and let dry.

Paint the heart, let dry.

Glue to the center of the painted earring.

Let dry, add varnish.

Use needlenose pliers to add jump ring and earring hook.
